- Please take care walking through our shop as much of our floor space is used as lay-down areas for our products

You are required to wear Personal Protective Equipment while in our shop(s). Your Westlake Representative will ensure that you are wearing appropriate PPE and/or will provide you with such items as may be necessary. Your co-operation is appreciated.



VISITOR CHECKLIST

1. **All visitors MUST “sign-in” upon arrival. All visitors must remain in the company of a Westlake employee at all times unless authorized by management.**
2. CSA approved safety glasses shall be worn by all visitors at all times while in the shop. Contact the Receptionist if you require safety glasses.
3. CSA approved safety toe protection shall be worn at all times by all visitors entering any fabrication areas in the plant. Contact the Receptionist if you require safety toe protection. (NOTE: “Closed” dress shoes may be worn provided visitors remain within the aiseways at all times. Open-toed shoes/sandals are never permitted anywhere in the shop area.)
4. All loose clothing or long hair must be secured when engaged around moving machinery. All jewellery (rings, watches, bracelets, etc.) is to be removed when engaged around moving parts/machinery.
5. No visitor shall use or operate any equipment, machine, device or thing without receiving prior permission from management.
6. Help Preserve the Environment -- Please use the appropriate recycling containers located throughout the facility for your plastic bottles, aluminum cans, paper, etc.
7. Do not pour any substances down any drains/sewer lines.
8. No visitor shall enter company premises while under the influence of, carrying, or consuming any alcohol, narcotic, controlled drug or any substance that impairs their ability.
9. Smoking is only permitted outside, away from entry/exit doors.
10. In the event of an emergency evacuation, all visitors are to proceed immediately to the marshalling area (see emergency evacuation plan). Do not re-enter the building for any reason until you are authorized to do so from management.
11. All injuries or illnesses must be reported to the Westlake representative.

Management has the right to remove any visitor from the premises who is in violation of Westlake Safety Rules.
